

THE IMPORTS AND EXPORTS CONTROL REGULATIONS, 1941

Licence is hereby granted to the Applicant specified to export the within-described goods to the destination stated in the application, subject to such conditions, restrictions and limitations as are specified therein. This Licence is valid for one month from date of issue and no longer.

Note—

The attention of exporters is drawn to the following regulations:

- (i) The Imports and Exports Control Regulations.
- (ii) The Exchange Control Act, 1970.
- (iii) The Defence (Exportation of Valuables) Regulations.

In the case of Exportation of Aquarium Fish, the following is a condition of this Licence:

- (i) The Fisheries Division of the Ministry of Agriculture, Land and Marine Resources, St. Clair Circle, Port-of-Spain, must be notified, at least forty-eight (48) hours prior to each shipment, of the time of departure and Flight Number of the carrier.
